The inner rooms are welcoming with an elegant, peaceful air, with the 14 inner courtyards, the splendid garden, and the swimming pool stands out from the ensemble. The bedrooms, installed in the former monastic cells, also offer peace and quiet. Beautiful galleries, wood, and latticework complete the inner atmosphere. In the restaurant, the traditional recipes of La Mancha are accompanied by Arabic influences, among which can be mentioned pisto manchego

(tomato-based ratatouille), migas (fried breadcrumbs), the cod dishes mojete and tiznao and Almagro aubergines.
