The current monastery was founded on this site and **run by the Order of San Benito until the**

**Desamortización** de 1835 (Large-scale selling of State and Church assets).

The monastery was recognized a **National Monument** in 1907, and features an added wing of perfectly harmonious architectural and constructional qualities: truly a jewel **set on the green banks of the River Sella**, in whose waters the hotel is reflected. In the background, guests can contemplate the majestic **landscape of the Picos de Europa**.

This Parador, has **comfortable and modern facilities**, and it is the ideal starting point from which to discover the delights of the **Asturian landscape**, and sample the best and most authentic of its rich **gastronomic tradition**.
