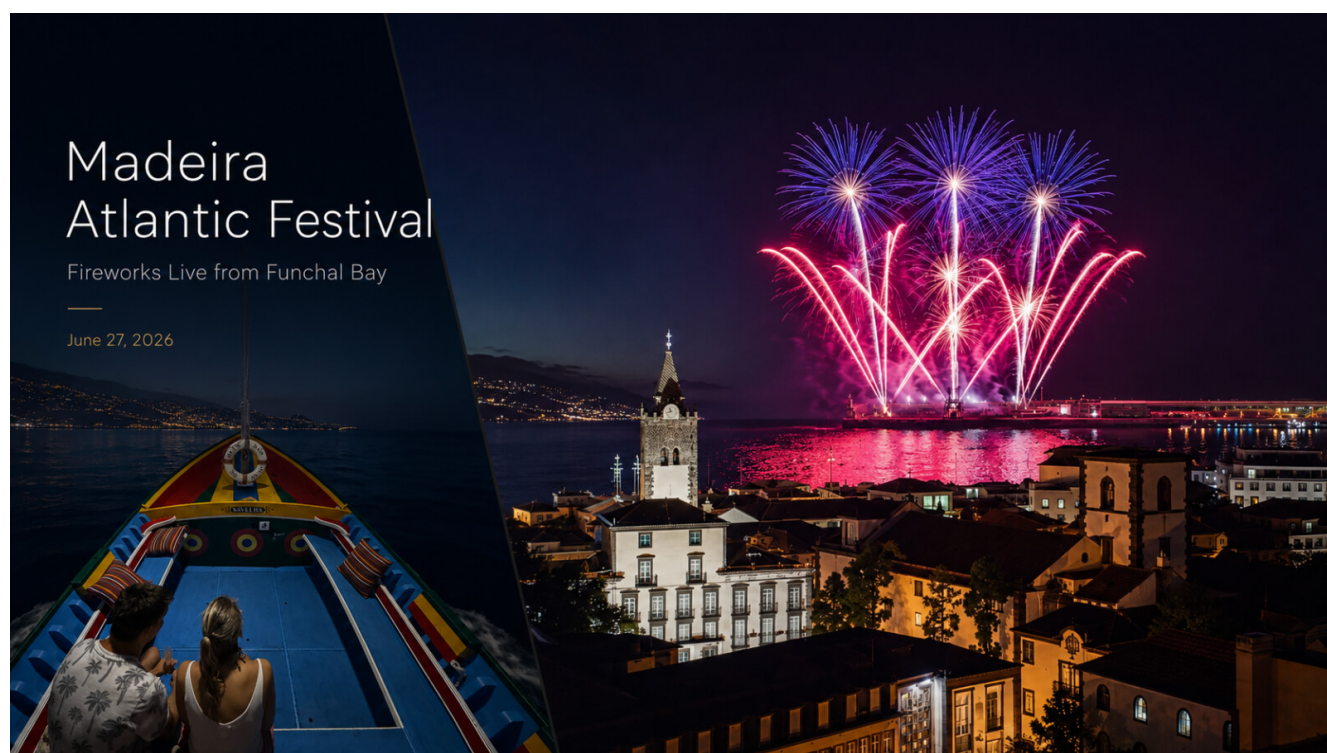

### What is a Xavelha boat?

A Xavelha is a traditional wooden fishing boat connected with Madeira's maritime heritage, especially the fishing traditions of Câmara de Lobos. Today, restored Xavelha boats offer a small-scale and authentic way to experience Madeira from the Atlantic.

### Is this virtual experience free?

Yes, this live virtual experience is free. You only need to register in advance to receive the YouTube Live link.

### Where does the live experience take place?

We will begin along Funchal's waterfront before walking to Marina do Funchal, where we board the Xavelha boat and sail into Funchal Bay to watch the Atlantic Festival fireworks from the water.
