cheeses, charcuterie and ham too).

- Wine is our passion. But we love to have fun with the wine. So, instead of those traditional formal and technical (and sometimes boring) wine tastings, we are promising you a really fun, informal and special experience. Passion is contagious. You are going to have a great time.
- Most of the wines served at the Portuguese Wine Tasting have less than 6000 bottles in the market, so they are not in the big commercial circuit and you won't find them outside Portugal. These little treasures come from small producers, traditional families, passionate wine makers that have become friends.
- You will taste 5 top boutique Portuguese wines, from small producers (normally, 2 whites, 2 reds and 1 Port). The selection is always different. The sommeliers choose having in mind the group, outside temperatures, new discoveries or just their mood.
- End of the experience.
- Lunch and Dinner on your own.
- Return to your hotel on your own.
- Overnight in Lisbon.


