- The visit ends with a wine-tasting session, paired with a tapa to enhance your experience.
- Continue the journey through the picturesque Pasiegos Valleys and soak in the beauty of its rolling hills and scenery.
- **01:30PM:** Lunch at a Local Restaurant in the Pasiegos Valleys. (**NOTE:** Lunch not included. You pay what you ordered directly at the restaurant.)
- Panoramic drive through the valleys, leading up to Mirador de la Braguía.

- Head to Selaya and visit Sobaos Joselín, where you'll explore the facilities and learn about the history of these traditional Cantabrian desserts at the Sobao and Quesada Museum.
- You will also experience a guided tasting of their delicious products.
- **06:30PM:** After a day full of fascinating discoveries, stunning views, and delicious flavors, we will make our way back to Santander, bringing your unforgettable Cantabria experience to a close.
